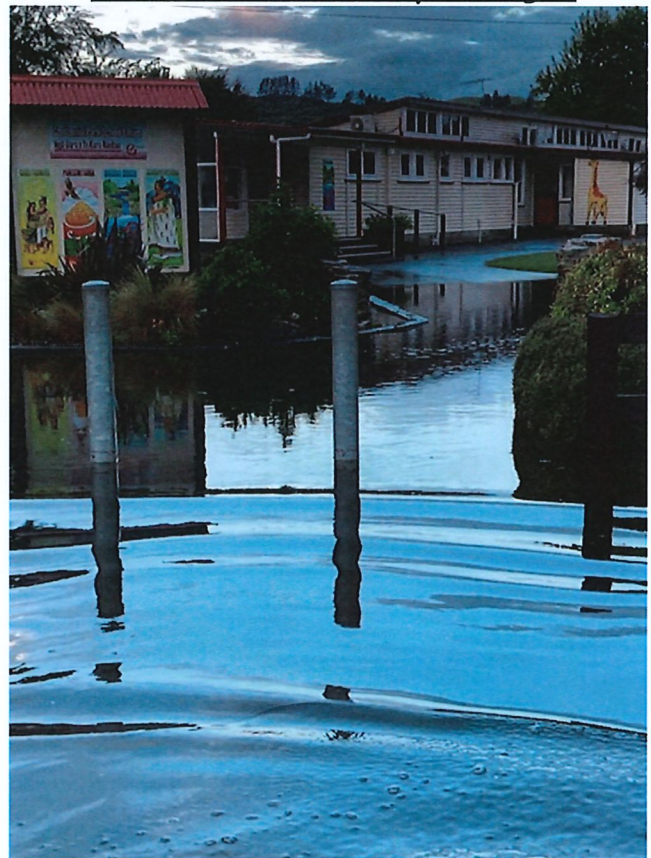

What happened at the kura during the flood? Was there any damage?

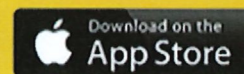


Once the rain stopped, the cleanup started. Here are some images from the front of the kura. We were lucky that none of the classrooms were affected.

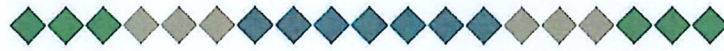
