Kia ora e te whanau,

The weather last Wed was not favorable for paddling so we hope next Tuesday works out to be fine. We have planned to go to Epworth (Maungatautari) for our tamariki to experience Waka Ama. A notice will be sent home to remind whanau of the date and times. (Tuesday 16th leaving kura by just after 9am). Thank you to those whanau who will travel with us and are available to help out.

There are some great examples of work coming through from tamariki about what they have learnt with 'raakau'. There have been some really creative ways of showcasing what and how they are applying their new skills. One example I have seen is an 'ebook' which shares the story of each of the different commands. Have a korero with your tamariki to see what they are doing. Some whanau may already be working with their tamariki through their padlet app.

We will have Yr 5-6 & 7-8 teams entered in the Technology Challenge at the stadium on the 1st April. This is always a great opportunity for tamariki to test themselves with problem solving and working together as a team.

The camp to Te Hape has been postponed until the last week of Term 1. We are planning to go for 2 x nights (from the 12th - 14th April) There will be no costs to whanau for this trip. It will be part 2 of Project Mana Tu Mana Ora. Notices will be sent home so whanau are able to set aside dates and plan accordingly. Many thanks for your support.

This Wednesday, the kura have planned to travel to Epworth (near Maungatautari) for Waka Ama. Hopefully the weather is fine. Notices were sent home so whānau could fill in any health or other concerns they have. This will be an exciting time for a lot of them as they would not have been in a waka before. We will be taking precautionary measures to ensure their safety on the water.
