Industrial Strike Action – So what does this mean for the kura?

Kia ora e te whanau,

This is a notice to confirm that Centennial Park School along with all other schools including secondary schools in our area and throughout New Zealand will be taking Strike Action on Thursday the 16th March (this week). What this means is Teachers and Principals who are part of the NZEI or PPTA Unions will be taking strike action on the 16th March.

We understand this is extremely inconvenient during a working week for our whaanau, however the negotiations with Government have fallen well short of expectations. Unfortunately, by conducting strike action, this was one way of sending a message to the Ministry of Education and Gov't to do better with meeting expectations.

We will still have support staff at kura and maybe one or two other staff who will not be striking, however there is no expectation on them to teach any student should they turn up to kura. Tamariki will be supervised if there is no other option and you are in a situation that your child will need to attend kura because of your work commitments. Please contact the kura to let us know if you are in this situation and will have no other option but to send your tamariki to kura on the 16th March.

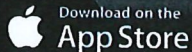
