Kia ora e te whanau,

We welcome our new students and whanau in our junior classes. We know you will enjoy your learning experiences and making lots of new friends here at Te Kura Rautau.

It is great to have heard the positive feedback from both staff and students about the lunch program here at the kura. As we work our way through and fine tune operations, it makes the job easier when everyone is in support.

I had a few discussions with students about the actual costs. If the Ministry of Education have committed to the cost of each student having a healthy lunch which is worth \$5 each, how would that work out in savings for whanau? So at \$5 per day x 5 days = \$25 / week. There are approx. 10 weeks in a term, so that equals to \$250 per term. There are 4 x terms in a year, so that is a total of \$1000.00 per child in costs per year. If you were to put that aside in a jar, what could you do with that amount of money? And if you have more than one child, well let's just say that it is a very significant amount of savings for whanau - and a great opportunity to put some savings aside for the end of the year.

We had hoped to have a whole kura Hakari - Whaanau whaanui kai tahi but this will be now at the end of this term to tie in with Matariki. Pencil in Thursday 8th July.

Our mid-year reporting to whanau will be coming up soon as well. These are student led which is important for them to share their learning journeys with you along side the Kaiako. We will be sending out a panui about this at a later date.
