During the July holiday's, most staff will be updating their First Aide Certificates. For some it will be a refresher and for others a full course. Having all staff certified ensures they have the skills and ability to handle situations as first responders in an emergency. Well done to all our staff for doing this for our kura and community.

Community Update - Policy

COVID-19 Information and Procedures

This policy was last updated on **2 May 2022.**

At Centennial Park School – Te Kura Rautau, we comply with all measures set at the government level to respond to and manage COVID-19, including the New Zealand government’s **COVID-19 Protection Framework (traffic lights)** .

Our school complies with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 to manage risks and protect staff, students, and our community. We are guided by the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education, and our procedures may be subject to frequent change or update. Such changes are notified to the community through a range of **communication channels**.

At all settings (Red, Orange, Green), Centennial Park School – Te Kura Rautau is open for onsite learning for all students. We carry out regular detailed risk assessment to manage COVID-19 at different settings.

Teaching and learning

Centennial Park School – Te Kura Rautau is open to all students for onsite learning. Those with underlying medical conditions should take extra precautions. Students with complex medical needs can seek advice from their health professional about whether it is appropriate to come to school.

Centennial Park School – Te Kura Rautau supports off site learning for students who are advised to remain at home or are required to self-isolate.

Wear a mask

Anyone required to wear a **mask** is expected to do so, unless they have an **exemption**.

At **ORANGE**, we:

- strongly encourage masks to be worn by students and staff in years 4 and above when indoors
- regularly assess for risks in our school and community, and if necessary, require staff and students in years 4 and above to wear a mask indoors, or when in close contact with others – for classes with a mixture of year 4 students and below, we make a pragmatic decision about mask requirements, taking a cautious approach
- require students aged 12 years and over, and staff, to wear a mask on school transport and public transport
- require all visitors to comply with the mask requirements in place at the time of their visit.

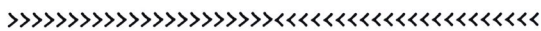
Did you know?

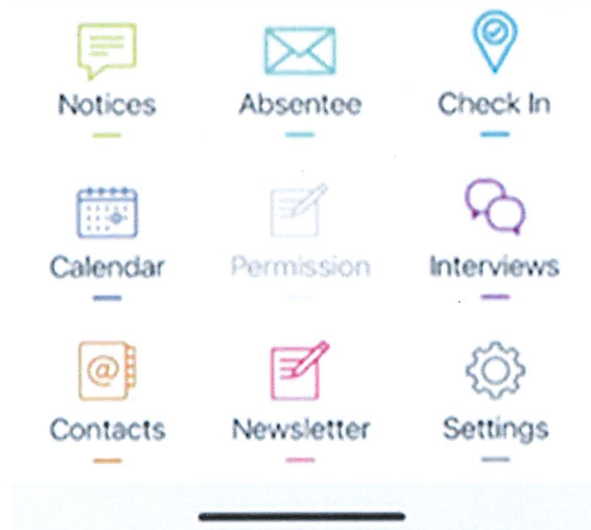
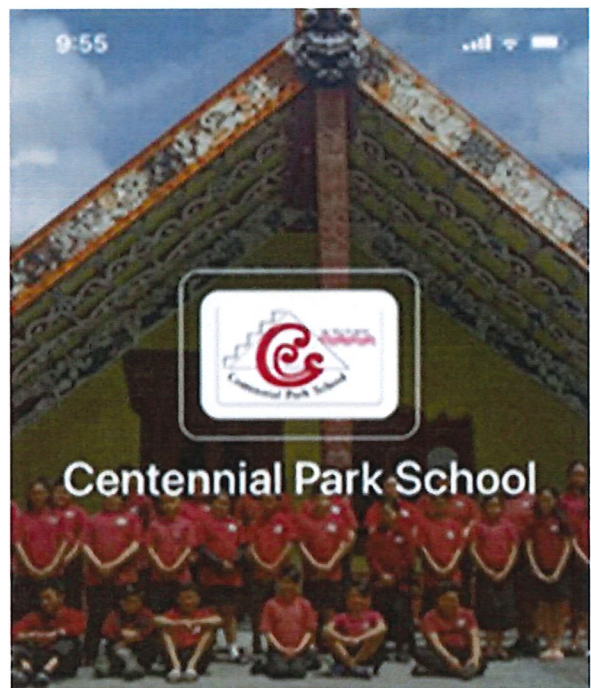
