No Strike Action by Primary School Teachers on Wednesday this week. Still come to kura – all day – a full day

The Teachers Union NZEI are still negotiating through the processes and will be meeting with the Finance Minister and Education Minister today. Last week, we sent out a pre-warning to our whaanau of the potential strike that may occur so they can prepare should it go ahead. Strike Action will not go ahead – at this stage until an agreed set of terms are settled. In the meantime, we carry on and encourage all tamariki to be at kura.

SAFETY ONLINE:

The Ministry's Cyber Security Programme provides support and services to address issues affecting schools / kura. Whenever the Ministry know about malware or other cyber issues, they will contact the affected school directly with advice and next steps to take.

Given the size of the education sector, cyber threats against schools | kura, tertiary, universities and wānanga, students | ākonga and the wider community are likely. BYO devices can be risky, so, prevention is the key. We recommend you and your communities keep devices up-to-date, use anti-virus software, make sure any software is downloaded from trusted and verified sources and use long unique passwords. For staff, turn two-factor authentication on for your accounts.

Cyber security issues regularly grab media attention, and the Ministry, and its partners, will work to support schools | kura.
