A sudden cold blast has certainly reminded us that winter is here. Stay warm and dry whanau. We have been updated by The Warehouse local senior management team that they will continue to hold supplies of our school uniform. This is great news as there was a wee rumor around the village that all schools would be effected and supplies would no longer continue. This is apparently not correct. We are pleased to be able to continue having our school uniforms provided by either The Warehouse or Sign Co (next to the old post office).

I was asked the other day why we have our office staff calling homes in the morning to see why a child is away. It is really simple actually. What if your child does not arrive at kura, yet they may have left home, how would you feel? Lucky for us this has not happened. This is about safety and learning. We need your tamariki at kura consistently to learn however, if they are sick, keep them at home.

We are trialing the School Loop App system to communicate with whanau at the kura for the parent interviews and appointments. Loading this School Loop app onto your phone means we can keep in contact. We would really like to see how we can now manage when students are away when they are either ill or away for personal reasons. Try using the School Loop App to let us know. Thank you for supporting this.

We have been given a limited supply of little beanies (potae) that we will give out to our juniors at the start of Term 3. Have an awesome week whanau. Keep dry, warm and safe.

Whaea Hana and Whaea Helen (our nannies) are available from 10am -2pm and anytime in between here at the kura





