Update on Footpath - making it safer and tidy on Park Street / Te Kuiti Road

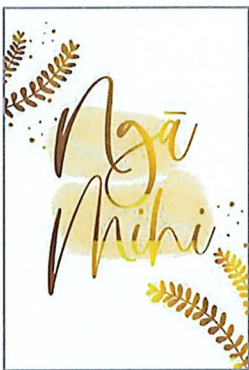

Waitomo Miniball Association is holding a pre-season tournament for the Year 7 & 8 Grade.

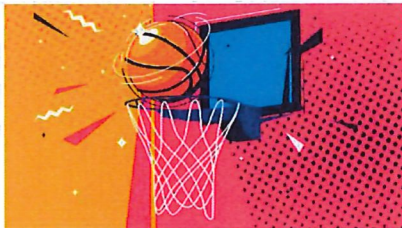
