A Transition Roadshow to help support and prepare:

The purpose of the roadshow is to provide an opportunity for students with additional needs and their whānau to understand what options and supports are available to them in our local geographical area. Although this roadshow will be mainly targeting students for when they leave school, there is something for everyone and Primary aged whaanau can help prepare for the time their tamariki leave.

The expo will have stallholders specific to our location. The aim of the expo is to have a range of stalls with local support providers sharing what support they can offer young people as they prepare to leave school and step into the community. There will be a morning and afternoon session at each expo, with presentations on the funding stream options for young people with additional needs.

Training for the Year 7 & 8 will begin this week as we head into the tournament next week.

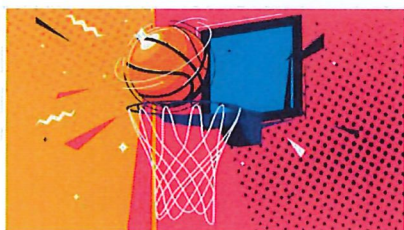
This tournament will be held after school hours on
