Miniball Begins



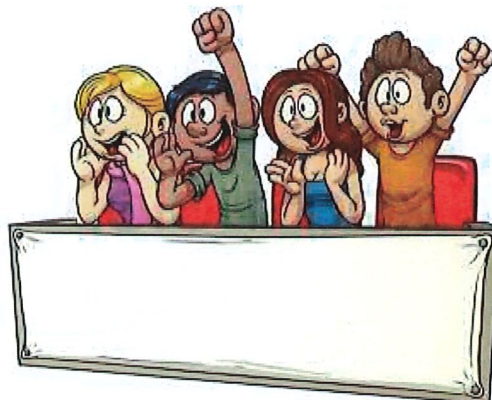
