- NO raffles (apart from Legendary Te Kuiti) and NO lucky dips.
- Stall sites are approx. 3m x 3m. You are required to bring your own gazebo, tables, chairs etc. Power sites are not available
- The cost is \$20 per stall
- No refunds will be given due to weather
- Stall spaces will be assigned on a first come/first served basis

FOOD STALLS are offered ONLY to local non-profit community groups, as an opportunity for them to fundraise for their organisation.

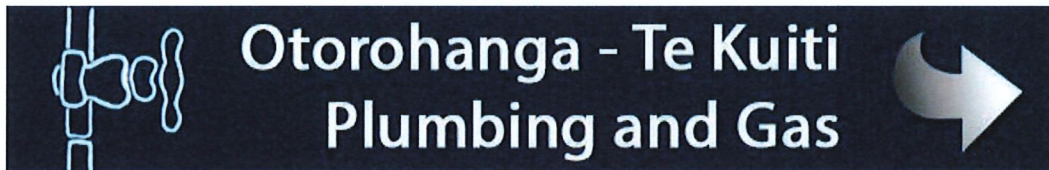
