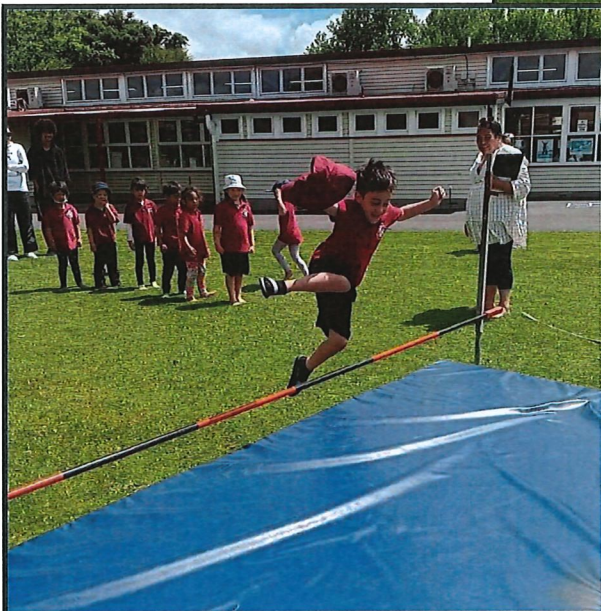
CP Taiaha: Year 7 & 8's - Powered through the day playing top notch teams. You always found your spark on the court, even if it was just having fun out there.
